CERN SKI CLUB

- Founded in 1963 under the patronage of the <u>CERN Staff</u> <u>Association</u>
- It is an association governed by the French law of the 1st July 1901 and affiliated with the French Ski Federation (Committee Mont Blanc). Its statutes and internal regulations have been approved by the general assembly.
- Non-profit association with more than 1000 active members





NON PROFIT ASSOCIATION

- The club is run by volunteers who help on the different activities
- The activities of the club are organised by its <u>committee</u> composed of 15 members
- We rely on instructors in the different sections, all of them trained under the FFS (French Federation of Ski)
 - Alpine (~50)
 - Snowboard (~19)
 - Touring (~5)
 - Cross-country (~10)
 - Ski fitness (external instructor)
- The offer of courses depends on the number of available instructors.

TOURING SKI

An average 25/30 outings in the season

- Different outings difficulties:
 - Easy (F,S1-2, <+800m) up to three hours of skiing up and mild ski down
 - Moderate (PD-/PD, S3, <+1100m) three to four hours of skiing uphill and challenging ski down
 - Advanced (PD+/AD-, S3 >+1100m) with more than four hours of the way up and a demanding ski down
- Minimum ski level: 3.0/Easy black piste
- **Registration**: every Thursday before scheduled outings *Fair-share* basis: minimum of 3 outings ensured.
- Compulsory Practice sessions on the avalanche rescue will take place on: Sunday 07/01/24, Saturday 13/01/24

Off-piste ski

INITIATION (3.0TN)

- Skiers with a sound technical base (can handle black runs without problems) who want to discover non groomed runs
- Not very familiar with the use of safety gear and/or snow conditions
- What can you expect from this course: your instructor will
 - work mostly on skiing technique in a comfortable off-piste
 - will teach /safety concepts including the use of the safety gear

INTERMIDIATE/ADVANCED (3.5TN)

- Skiers with a sound technical base and that have experience offpiste (confident and comfortable skiing off piste in moderate terrain)
- Familiar with the use of safety gear (avalanche transceiver, snow shovel and probe)
- What can you expect from this course: your instructor will
 - work mostly on skiing technique according to the different types of terrain
 - tips on how to early identify potential threats and navigate accordingly and improving your skills to become more autonomous in the mountains

Kids group

- Package: 5 x full days of instruction (full pack only)
- On Saturdays (for the course package) one small group for children (if enough sign up).
- The minimum age accepted is 9 years, they must be able to ski independently with a group (3*) for a full day and have some pocket money for lunch.
- A responsible adult must be on the same outing but does not have to accompany the children group

Bring a friend

The "pass decouverte" option allows a non-member to join once.

It's not possible to participate in a pack- aged course this way but they can join a group on the non-package outings from mid February.

If the person wishes to return, this one-off membership must be upgraded to a full membership.

Outings post-courses

- full day with instructor
- groups formed ad-hoc on arrival
- transport (bus), lift passes and instructor included
- weekend outings: hotel included.
- Price: The remaining activities are signed up for individually (membership required), and the prices vary between 50-90 EUR (one day outings) and 200-500 EUR (weekend outings)

SNOWBOARD

Levels (goals)

- Understand your snowboarding hardware and settings
 Learn how to warm up using all the muscles put to use while snowboarding
 Behave according to FIS rules, respecting nature and instructions of the instructor
 One foot skating to move about the ski area, flats, etc.
 Slide, skid and stop on heel and toe side of the snowboard
 Sliding/skidding turns heels and toes, linking turns
 - Stop quickly with counter-rotation
 Waltzes in both directions
 Turning variations, using techniques such as rocking and flexion / extension
 Learn how to ride a ski lift (téléski) safely

Initiation to switch, wheelies (tail press) and small jumps

- CarvingInitiation to short turns
 - Switch descent with linked turns on easy terrain
 - Jumps using ollie / nollie
 - Nose and tail Wheelie/Butter leading to...Noseslide and tailslide
 - 180 ° spins
 - Nose / tailturn and flat tricks in genera

Learn how to ride ski lifts (téléski)

Carving and carving switch

180° spin variations

Nose / tailturns, front and back

Nose / tailspin

Introduction to 360°, freestyle and freeride in general
